Update on the YMCA project.

Donations made directly to the YMCA from the Aberfeldy congregational members and monies donated through the church from members and Session amounted to approx. £1400. The monies are going to support a group of young folks to go on a YMCA Christian Camp, called Youth Unify, sometime this summer. These young folk are currently fundraising to allow them to attend the Camp and this donation from APC will give them a much appreciated boost.
