

# HOW TO UNDERSTAND THE BIG PICTURE





Hermeneutics: study of how we understand, interpret and apply the plain meaning of scripture.



With the 'big story' in mind, when we read the Bible, we consider:

- the type of literature we are reading
- the context it was written in at the time so we can understand
- what it meant at that time
- to consider how we apply it to our lives now.



#### The history of hermeneutics:

- Jesus quoted from the Old Testament as historical fact
- Jesus rejected interpretation governed by tradition
- Jesus did not 'allegorise'
- The apostles quoted the Old Testament
- The Reformation (Luther, Clavin etc) emphasised that the church should teach from scripture alone and that each apart is understood by using the Bible as a whole



#### Principles:

- Be aware of your own personal presuppositions.
- Acceptance of the divine inspiration of scripture.
- The Bible is not written in deliberately ambiguous language
- Use the studies of others.
