Walking with a First Holy Communion child

I would like to extend a warm welcome to all the First Holy Communion Children and their parents who will celebrate the Rite of Enrolment at 9.15am this weekend. There are 43 children coming forward this year to celebrate their first Holy Communion in May 2026. I wish to congratulate the First Holy Communion Children and their parents for presenting them to the parish for this special journey to receive Jesus in the Holy Communion.

The First Holy Communion preparation among various things is a unique way of helping our children to become more aware of the spiritual richness and beauty of the Holy Eucharist and Holy Mass. During this preparation period, children will understand the importance of expressing reverence and acknowledge appreciation towards the Holy Eucharist. The methodology of learning about Holy Mass with their friends will assist them to understand more about it and to enjoy attending Mass with the wider parish community. Therefore it is important that parents provide the opportunity for their child to attend Mass every weekend in the Parish to see and enjoy the beauty of Holy Mass which they may probably struggle to comprehend at the First Holy Communion session. Indeed as part of your commitment, parents are requested to attend weekly the weekend Mass in the parish with their child. Parents can significantly accompany their child in his/her preparation for the First Holy Communion in the following ways.

- -Parents may dedicate five to seven minutes each day to sit with their child in saying together the prayers they learn at the sessions.
- Similarly, please talk with your child after each session about what they have learned from the session they attended.

We as a parish community are reminded also that it is our responsibility to accompany these children in their faith journey. Our prayers and good examples will invite them to know Jesus more and to grow in a sense of belonging to the Parish community. The faith that we cherish in life should be handed over to the coming generation in order to enable them to face the challenges of life and to build up the faith community by inheriting the culture of faith transmitted to them in the parish. Let this special time in the parish be an inspiration and invitation for many to renew the faith.
