been reading it, I have come to appreciate ever more deeply just how that vision, together with the immense generosity and

commitment of many people in our parish, gave life to the Parish Centre we have today.

They worked with a determination to turn their vision into reality, which took 10 years in the making. I'm thrilled that Roger will be



joining us to share some of the story of this inspirational journey during our worship and celebrations on Sunday. Please join us for the celebration service at 10.30am and/or for refreshments afterwards. There will be photos, displays, a special cake, and a video of the opening.

It's wonderful to see how that vision continues to benefit so many people to this day. Every day of the week there is something going on in



the building, often multiple activities taking place at the same time. Amanda Blease and I have counted over 60 regular and occasional groups and activities that currently take place. It's a focal point for our church mission and ministry; it provides a place where we offer support for families, children and young people, and older people; it's home to many



community groups; we use it to support many other ministries and churches; it's our parish base for our staff team and office. And we thank God for it!
