How do we know of God's attributes?

- 1. Through His Word (the Bible)
- Revealed by His names.
- Revelated by what He has done.
- Revealed by descriptions.

2. Revealed in creation.

For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse.
