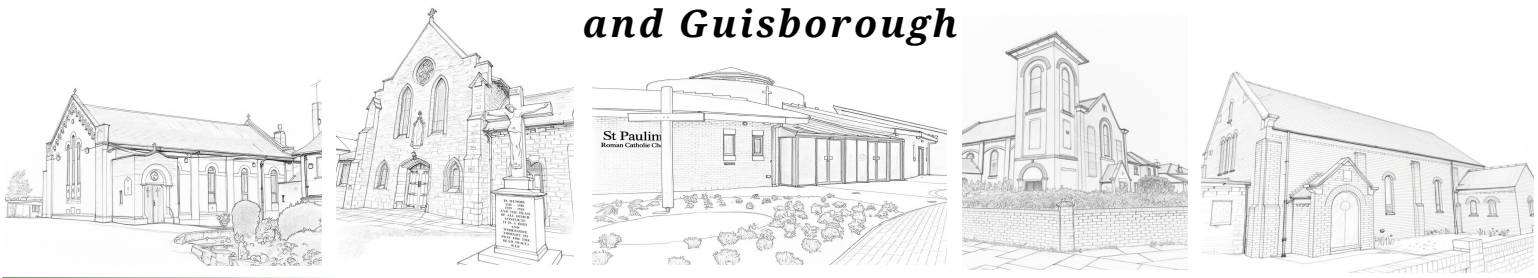

CLERGY REFLECTION:

Our readings this week for the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time invite us to reflect on the kind of change that God desires within us. In our first reading, Abraham boldly intercedes for the people, showing a heart transformed by compassion and trust in God's mercy. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches His disciples to pray, giving us the Lord's Prayer and encouraging perseverance: *"Ask, and it will be given to you."* Prayer is not simply about changing God's mind; it changes us. As we bring our needs before the Father, our hearts become more open, patient, and aligned with His will. That *His* will is done and not our own. St. Paul reminds us in Colossians that through Christ we have been raised to new life. This Sunday challenges us to allow God's grace to renew us, so that our words, actions, and relationships may reflect the mercy and generosity we ourselves have received. ~ Fr. Peter
