# THE BIG TRANSFORMATION

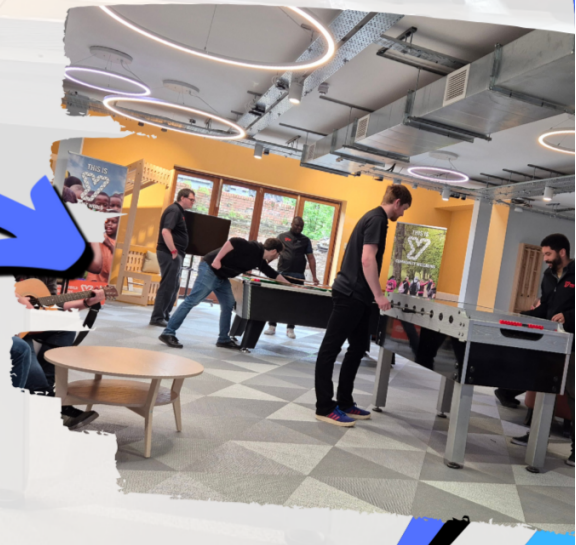


Many of you will know of our association with Tayside YMCA over many years. Franny and Jill McGrath of 'the Y' have been significant influencers of and participants in our Breathe project. (Few of you will remember the early days when Franny came to town in a red double decker bus). Throughout almost 25 years the Breathe work has grown to be one of the biggest youth projects of its kind, touching the lives of countless youngsters in Aberfeldy and around.

Almost 5 years ago, Tayside YMCA started on a massive project to convert a musty, dilapidated old church into a modern, state of the art youth centre. The project is finished at a cost of approximately of £7.5 million and it is truly an amazing facility.

Within the building is a donors' wall where 'bricks' will display those organisations/people who have donated to this amazing project. Session recently agreed that APC should be a 'brick' donor and will contribute £500, hopefully matched by donations from the APC congregation.

A visit is being planned to the centre where congregation members will be able to see the transformational work which has been completed. Refreshments will be provided by our hosts. (There may even be an opportunity to sing 'you cannae shove yer granny aff the bus' on the way).
