Did you know that last Sat 11 Oct was the 185<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the consecration of St Peter's Church



# Prayer from Hilary Peake on behalf of St Peter's Church: SEASONS

God has given us seasons to bring order from chaos. God created the heavens and the earth to mark the seasons (Genesis 1). God blessed those who walked with him who yield fruit in their season (Psalm 1). There is a time for everything and a season for every activity under heaven (Ecclesiastes 3). Be prepared in season and out of season to correct, rebuke and encourage with great patience and careful instruction (2 Timothy 4:2).
