Children, Young People and Families

Did you know that the Church of England are aiming to double the number of children and young people in our churches by 2030? As part of this the vision is to have 30,000 new recruits as volunteers or paid children and youth leaders. Sunday 13 July is a national week of recognition for everyone involved in ministry with children, young people, and their families (CYPF). If we don't have ministry for CYPF in our churches, let's start praying for them and for the leaders and volunteers to work with them!

Catalyst

As part of this ambition for 30,00 new workers with children and young people, Catalyst is a funded course run through Ridley Hall in Cambridge. The students cover a range of topics including how young people learn, culture, discipleship and inclusion. Modules are mainly by Zoom and self-study. Open the Book Training

Open the Book (OtB) is a national organisation, part of the Bible Society. It is an exciting storytelling project where Bible stories are shared with children in a way that is fun, interactive and memorable. As invited guests in school, storytelling teams use the <u>Open the Book programme</u> to prepare and present a 10–15-minute scripted Bible story to a school assembly, involving the children as much as possible. There will be a local introductory training session Wednesday 17 September, 4-6pm for anyone who may wish to consider joining a team to help deliver Bible Stories in our school assemblies.
